### Illness reporting:

## **Celebration Worship/productions - photography:**



We would like to ask that you do not film or take any photos during Celebration Worship or school performances – you will often have the opportunity to take photos at the end. If you are taking group photos at the end, please ensure you have permission from the other children's parents/carers beforehand. Please also ask for permission from anyone included in your photos before sharing to social media. This is for safeguarding purposes and ensures we keep our children and families safe.

#### Reception Nativity - Tuesday:



Reception children will be performing their Nativity play in school on Tuesday (9<sup>th</sup> December) at 2.30pm, in the school hall. Seating will be available on a first come first served basis – please enter through the main school office. As stated in the letter which was sent out in October, we kindly ask that you restrict your numbers to a maximum of three people (per child) per performance. This is to allow for maximum seating capacity and fire safety in the hall.
