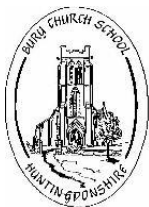

Please could all children come into school wearing school uniform - children that are doing PE that day (Years 3 and 5) DO NOT need to bring in their PE uniform as they will be doing an adapted lesson which they can do in their school uniform. Sports Day:



Sports Day this year is taking place on Friday 22nd May. We will be doing sport all day so the children should come in sports kit (preferably a 'house' coloured t-shirt), colours are; Mars – Red, Saturn – Yellow, Pluto – Green, Neptune - Blue.
