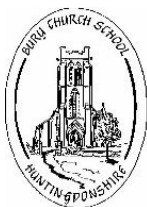
Please don't forget to sign your child up if they would like to part in the Harvest Festival service at Bury Church on 19th October – enrol via MCAS.

Parent/Carer 'Book Look' morning – Tuesday 14th October (8.45am):

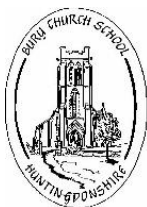
