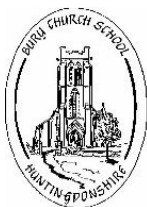

Booking school meals:

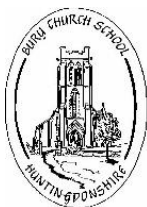
