### Dinner monies:



Another reminder to please ensure you do not have any debt remaining on your child's School Grid account. We will be in touch, after the end of term, with Year 6 parents/carers who have any credit remaining on their accounts to arrange refunds/transfers to siblings.

### PE days and uniform:



PE days for each class will be communicated to you at the beginning of next term. Children will still be required to come into school in PE uniform on their allocated PE days from September. PE uniform consists of royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan/fleece (this can be their school top), black/blue shorts (as close to knee length as possible) / jogging trousers, plain t-shirt (no branding/logos/slogans) – this can be white or house colour – and plain coloured trainers, preferably black or white. Hoodies and football kits should not be worn. Parents/Carers will be contacted if PE uniform is not appropriate – e.g., shorts are too short.

### KS2 (Years 3 – 6) meals/snacks:



Parents/carers of children in Y2 moving up to Y3 should be aware that school meals will become chargeable to them (and all KS2 children) from September. Meals will be charged at £3 and should be paid via SchoolGrid. You will only be charged for the meal when it has been taken so do not worry if your child is absent on a day that you had pre-ordered their meal. We would recommend setting up a Direct Debit through SchoolGrid in order to avoid your account going into debt. It is worth noting that there is always a chilled option available (sandwiches etc) if your child would prefer this to a hot meal. Jacket potatoes are also available daily.



KS2 children should also bring in a healthy fruit or veg snack for morning break, if they wish (these are only provided to Reception and KS1 children under the Government's School Fruit and Vegetables Scheme).

### Pencil cases:



Children in KS2 may choose to bring in a pencil case for the classroom. These must be **small** (should be able to fit in their tray) and may contain pencils, rubber, pencil sharpener, small ruler, and pencil crayons. Please **do not** send in any gel pens, felt tips, highlighters, tippex or compasses. Please note, bringing in a pencil case is optional.

### Ear piercing:



We have had some issues with children not being able to remove their newly pierced earrings for PE. We would suggest if you are getting your child's ears pierced that you do so at the very beginning of the summer holidays to allow for the required 6 weeks before being able to remove/change them. If your child is not able to remove their earrings for any reason, they will be asked to take part in lower risk, simplified PE activities on their own (stretching/jogging on the spot/star jumps etc.) but will not be allowed to take part in the full PE lesson with the rest of the class.
