School meals - allergies:



Further to the email which was sent out earlier this week, as of Monday, if your child is recorded on our system as having an allergy but we have not yet received a completed allergy menu request, they will automatically be provided with a 'safe meal' (a jacket potato) at lunchtime (if they are having school meals). If you have not already done so, and you would prefer your child to choose from the main school menu instead, please send us an email confirming that you take full responsibility for their meal selections.

Pencil cases:



From September, children in Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6) will no longer need to bring their own pencil cases to school, as all necessary stationery and equipment will be provided for them in class. To ensure everyone has the same resources and to keep desks clutter-free, please do not send your child in with a personal pencil case and equipment. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us prepare for the new school year.

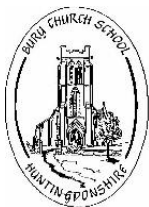
