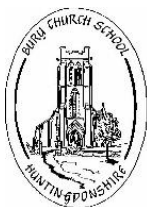

FoBS fundraiser - Krispy Kreme doughnuts:

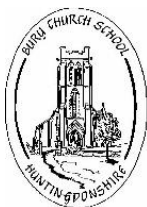
