Booking school meals:



Please log into **MCAS** to book (and pay for where necessary) your child's school meals before we return to school after half term. Please ensure that your School Grid account is clear of debt **as of today (Thursday 23rd October)** and do not place any food orders via School Grid for after half term. For those who have Direct Debit accounts with School Grid, final collection will run on 3rd November 25 – this will cover meals taken between 18th September and 17th October 25. Any meals taken after this date (this week) will need to be paid by card via School Grid. A report will be run tomorrow and any debt amounts showing will be carried over to MCAS - school dinners will not be allowed to be taken until these debts are cleared. Credit amounts will also be allocated to your accounts.
