BOARD MEETING

- 2. Announcements and Board of Commissioners Comments. Commissioner Moore welcomed Chief Mays to the staff. Commissioner Casarez thanked the Lake Worth, Eagle Mountain, Saginaw, Sansom Park, Parker County and Fort Worth Fire Departments for responding to the Azle Fire that happened over the weekend.

- e. Presentation from Texas County and District Retirement System (TCDRS) on the proposed retirement program for Tarrant County ESD #1 employees. Mrs. Fox presented the board the proposed retirement package for Tarrant County ESD #1 employees.

Public hearing on the District's proposed 2025 Tax Rate of \$0.074348 per \$100 valuation, consisting of a separately adopted debt rate of \$0.00 per \$100 valuation and a separately adopted Maintenance and Operations Rate of \$0.074348 per \$100 valuation. President Davis opened the public hearing at 7:26pm President Davis closed the public hearing at 7:30pm.
- k. Commissioner Moore made a motion to adopt the Districts Tax rate of \$0.074348 per \$100 valuation, consisting of separately adopted debit rate of \$0.00 per \$100 valuation and separately adopted Maintenance and Operating Rate of \$0.074348 per \$100 valuation, and authorizing the appropriate District officers and officials to take necessary action to implement same and seconded by Commissioner Casarez. Motion passed unanimously.
- I. Discussion and/or action on the proposed Request for Qualifications for a construction Firm to construct fire stations within Tarrant County ESD #1. Commissioner Moore made a motion to approve the proposed request for qualifications for a construction firm to construct fire stations within Tarrant County ESD #1 and seconded by Commissioner Jones. Motion passed unanimously.
