

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

- Be at least 18 years of age or older
- Provide a clean Vulnerable Sector criminal background
- Be in good health: a pre-employment medical screening form signed by a nurse practitioner or doctor must be provided
- Successful completion of Secondary School Grade 12 or equivalent
- Possession of a valid class "G" Ontario drivers' licence
- Live within the township
- Prior firefighting experience and/or certifications is an asset but not required

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

In addition to the minimum qualifications listed above, the following items weigh heavily for selecting successful candidates:

- Availability to respond to emergency incidents during daytime hours on weekdays in addition to weeknights, weekends and overnight hours
- Primary residence located 5km or less
- Valid First Aid/CPR Level C
- Class D drivers license with Z endorsement (Ontario Issued)

There are many benefits to being a firefighter such as:

- Free training: All firefighting, rescue, CPR, first aid and other emergency training is provided
- NFPA Certifications in many disciplines
- Protective clothing and equipment are provided
- Uniforms are provided
- Compensation for attending emergency calls, training and other department activities as required
- Workers Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB) benefits
- Insurance benefits provided by Volunteer Firemen's Insurance Service Inc. (VFIS) including access to our Employee and Family Assistance Plan
- Leadership: There are opportunities for promotion and greater responsibility
- Family events, friendship and memories that last a lifetime
- Many opportunities to volunteer outside the department in our community
- DZ license reimbursement
