<p>Badge</p> 	<p><u>Outdoor Art Creator</u></p> <p>Go on a nature detective walk using our Forest Bingo board to look for plants, animals, and various sights, sounds and smells you might find in any forest. While on our nature walk, we'll collect leaves to use in a nature pigment art project! We'll discuss what gives leaves their colors, learn why they change in fall, and see how many of those colors we can capture in our art. Then we'll discuss the principles of photography and practice capturing pictures with a photo frame before taking our phones, tablets or cameras around the property to take some photos. We'll wrap up by discussing the Leave No Trace principles before building Brownie Elf houses.</p>
