Enhancing Learning

Research shows that students from schools who study in an outdoor curriculum tend to score higher in assessments in math, science, and attendance than those who did not receive the outdoor curriculum.



Positive Behavior

Research has shown that students' ability to behave in an educational setting is improved by learning outdoors and that outdoor education leads to better social adjustment and group cohesion, contributing to improved behavior in a group setting.



Stronger Health

Studies have found outdoor
education can help avoid
childhood obesity. The phrase
"nature-deficit disorder"
describes the adverse effects
of too much indoor
overstimulation, which may
lead to anxiety, depression,
ADHD, and obesity.
