A primary election is an election held before the general election where voters choose which candidates will represent a political party on the November ballot.

Texas uses an open primary system, meaning voters do not register with a political party in advance and can choose which party's primary to vote in on Election Day. **Voters may only participate in one party's primary per election cycle** and, if there is a runoff, must vote in the same party's runoff. Participating in a primary **does not** limit how someone can vote in the general election.
