## Paper to Reality

Last year at our Annual Benefit Dinner and Auction, we announced the next step in our vision: the construction of Cottage #4, a new home spanning over 5,000 square feet, which will provide care for up to ten additional children in need. We presented this project with an estimated cost of approximately \$1.3 million. A generous donor pledged to match dollar for dollar all contributions to the project up to \$500,000. The traditional Love Offering at the auction kicked off our fundraising efforts, with around \$250,000 dedicated to building this new safe haven for countless children in the future.

In late spring of this year, we finalized the architectural plans for the project and were able to break ground during our Annual Open House and BBQ on August 9, 2025. Today, Cottage #4 is officially underway, with construction trucks and contractors on-site daily, laying the foundation. We are witnessing the dreams of many before us becoming a reality, and the construction is set to be completed by the beginning of 2026.

Thank you, donors, for your prayers and support in making this dream a reality. There is still much work to be done to increase our revenue to support such a significant build, but we do not take for granted the many hearts and hands that have brought us this far. Whether through your substantial financial contributions or your commitment during our auction's Love Offering, we are deeply grateful to Christ our Lord for you.

We are excited to see what the next steps on this journey will look like and eagerly await the Lord's guidance on what He has in store for us. We ask that you continue to join us on this journey to help more children in need in our community and to open our Home to share Christ's love with the least of these.




This quarter, we wanted to combine the Heart for our Volunteers and Churches to highlight some amazing church volunteers from various congregations.
