



### GROWING SEASON NOTES

The 2025 growing season in Lake County was very favorable and produced high quality fruit. The season was marked by early winter rains leading to full water tables, followed by mild spring weather and an unusually cool summer.

### VINEYARD NOTES

The grapes are grown in the Red Hills appellation of Lake County known for its rolling hills and elevations ranging between 1400 and 3000 feet. With volcanic soils from neighboring Mount Konocti, the vineyard is well-drained with soil rich in black obsidian, volcanic gravel, and a bold red color.

### WINEMAKING NOTES

The Viognier grapes were hand-picked and were gently pressed to tank. After cold settling, the clean juice was racked, fermented to dryness, and aged on fine lees for 6 months before bottling.

### TASTING NOTES

This 2025 Viognier has vibrant aromas of citrus and stone fruits with touches of lemon zest and floral aromas. Bright and lively palate with subtle notes of white peach and lemon with a persistent minerality on the finish.
