

Brecknock Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes of Meeting – December 18, 2025

Call to Order: The regular monthly meeting of the Brecknock Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 5:01 PM at the Township Building by Chairman Jeff Fiant with Vice Chairman Ron McClure and Supervisor Jason Coyle present. Also present were Noah Weber, Road Crew, Erik Grunzig, Police Chief, Sheila McCune, Secretary/Treasurer, and several members of the public. The call to order was followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Public Comment Period on Agenda Items: None

Minutes: The minutes of the December 2, 2025, meeting were unanimously approved as written on a motion by Vice Chairman Ron McClure and seconded by Supervisor Jason Coyle.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report dated December 18, 2025, was unanimously approved on a motion by Chairman Jeff Fiant and seconded by Vice Chairman Ron McClure.

Unfinished Business:

2026 Budget: Motion to adopt the advertised 2026 budget was unanimously approved on a motion by Vice Chairman Ron McClure and seconded by Supervisor Jason Coyle.

2026 Tax Millage: Resolution 25-14 was unanimously approved on a motion by Vice Chairman Ron McClure and seconded by Supervisor Jason Coyle.

Weber AG Security: Motion to accept receipt of the Weber AG Security Berks County Planning Commission review letter and ratify prior approval and prior recording of the Weber parcel into the Township's ASA was unanimously approved on a motion by Chairman Jeff Fiant and seconded by Vice Chairman Ron McClure

2026 Joint Bid Roadwork: Motion to participate in 2026 joint bid for roadwork maintenance with Union and Robeson Townships was unanimously approved on a motion by Supervisor Jason Coyle and seconded by Vice Chairman Ron McClure.

Green Light Go Grant: Motion to accept the professional service agreement (PSA) from Traffic Planning and Design, Inc. recommended by Township Engineer, John Weber, to assist with the grant process was unanimously approved on a motion by Supervisor Jason Coyle and seconded by Vice Chairman Ron McClure.

New Business:

Veteran Tax Exemption Request: Motion to approve veteran tax exemption request for Elizabeth Albertson, 364 Beech Rd was approved on a motion by Chairman Jeff Fiant and seconded by Vice Chairman Ron McClure.

A 2026 spring/summer newsletter was discussed, and staff will work on mockup for approval by board.

The responsibilities and meeting requirements for elected Auditors were discussed, and a letter was sent to those elected explaining the process.

Adjournment: With no additional business, a motion was made by Supervisor Jason Coyle, seconded by Vice Chairman Ron McClure and unanimously approved to adjourn the meeting at 7:18pm.
