

Brecknock Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes of Meeting – March 3, 2026

Call to Order: The regular monthly meeting of the Brecknock Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:02 PM at the Township Building, by Chairman Jeff Fiant with members Ron McClure and Jason Coyle present. Also present were Elizabeth McGovern, Township Solicitor, John Weber, Township Engineer, Sheila McCune, Secretary/Treasurer, Erik Grunzig, Police Chief, Joel Lutz, Fire Chief, and several members of the public. The call to order was followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Public Comment Period on Agenda Items: None

Minutes: The minutes of February 3, 2026, Regular meeting was unanimously approved as written on motion by Ron McClure, seconded by Jason Coyle.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurers report dated 3/3/26, and payment of all bills and payrolls were unanimously approved on motion by Ron McClure seconded by Jason Coyle.

Unfinished Business:

New Maintenance Building: Jeff Fiant gave an update on the work, discussed final payments and an estimate provided by SL Technology to install phone and internet in the new building. The estimate of \$5, 328.50 was unanimously approved on a motion by Ron McClure, seconded by Jason Coyle.

Other Unfinished Business: None

New Business:

Data Center Ordinance: The Township Solicitor's office provided a template for a Data Center Ordinance due to the current influx and the potential negative impacts on the community.

Health Insurance Renewal: The Capital Blue Cross, May 2026, renewal notice shows a huge increase. The staff are working on negotiating a lower increase and potential options to change the health carrier.

Advertise Assistant Secretary/Treasurer Position: Motion was made by Jason Coyle, seconded by Ron McClure, and unanimously approved. Ron McClure is handling and will utilize Indeed.

Stoltzfus Poultry Barn Land Development: John Stoltzfus, JDJ Rentals, provided a written request for a full release of his escrow, 63,005.05. Engineer John Weber reviewed and recommended a partial release of \$52,765.70 (Release #1), leaving a balance of \$10,239.35. Jason Coyle made a motion to allow partial release of \$52,765.70, seconded by Jeff Fiant, and was unanimously approved.

Green Light Go Grant: Chief Erik Grunzig provided the Municipal Traffic Light agreements and resolution required to apply for the grant. Ron McClure made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-08, seconded by Jason Coyle, and was unanimously approved.

Vice-Chairman McClure presented the information on the EMC Reports in hand.

The annual State Ethics Forms are available and due May 1, 2026.

Jason Coyle questioned the allowable length of time checks for tax payments are to be deposited.

Resident asked for update regarding recycling bins and Vice-Chairman McClure confirmed that the recycling bins will be placed at the Brecknock Fire Company the slab has been laid.

Lisa Peterson, Recreation Board, mentioned the upcoming Colliers of Brecknock Township Event, which is being held on March 5, 2026, at 7pm, snow date March 12, 2026. This event was planned by the Township Recreation Board and interested attendees are asked to call the Township office to register as there is limited space. The current headcount is 41.

Adjournment: Motion made by Ron McClure, seconded by Jason Coyle, and unanimously approved to adjourn the meeting at 7:31.
