

Brecknock Township Board of Supervisors  
Minutes of Meeting – April 7, 2026

---

Call to Order: The regular monthly meeting of the Brecknock Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 PM at the Township Building, by Chairman Jeff Fiant with members Ron McClure and Jason Coyle present. Also present were Sheila McCune, Secretary/Treasurer, Erik Grunzig, Police Chief, Joel Lutz, Fire Chief, and several members of the public. The call to order was followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag and a moment of silence was taken for the Honeybrook fire personnel that passed.

EMC Reports: Vice-Chairman McClure presented the information on the EMC Reports in hand.
