

Brecknock Township Board of Supervisors
Minutes of Meeting – June 4, 2026

Call to Order: The regular monthly meeting of the Brecknock Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 4:01 PM at the Township Building, by Chairman Jeff Fiant with members Ron McClure and Jason Coyle present. Also present were Christopher Hartman, Township Solicitor, Sheila McCune, Secretary/Treasurer, Erik Grunzig, Police Chief, Kyle Schlouck, Assistant Fire Chief, and several members of the public. The call to order was followed by the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Public Comment Period on Agenda Items: None

Minutes: The Board of Supervisors meeting minutes for May 6, 2026, were unanimously approved as written on motion by Jason Coyle, seconded by Ron McClure.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurers report dated June 4th, 2026, and payment of all bills and payrolls were unanimously approved on motion by Ron McClure seconded by Jason Coyle.

Unfinished Business:

Lamar Gockley, Land Preservation of 92-acre property: Engineer, John Weber, clarified that the property owners requested an additional parcel #34437302999517 be added to the original request for rezoning to allow for eligibility in the Township's Ag. Security program. Motion to add parcel to original request was unanimously approved, on a motion by Jason Coyle and seconded by Ron McClure.

Rise Up Towers, ZHB, Appeal: Chairman Fiant explained the board needed to discuss their position relative to the appeal and would have a short executive session. The board went into an Executive Session at 7:08 and reconvened at 7:16.

A motion to have the Solicitor respond in favor of the Zoning Hearing Board's decision was made by Jeff Fiant, seconded by Jason Coyle, and a Nay vote from Ron McClure, the motion passed.

Other Unfinished Business: None

New Business:

2026 Non-Uniform Wage Increase: Chairman Fiant made a motion to increase wages, retroactive date 1/1/2026 as follows; Admin staff – 7%, Road Master – 10%, and Road Crew – 7%, seconded by Ron McClure and passed unanimously.

A motion to increase tool reimbursement from \$100 to \$125, was approved unanimously with a motion by Jeff Fiant, seconded by Jason Coyle.

A motion to provide a boot allowance of \$200/year was approved unanimously with a motion by Jeff Fiant, seconded by Jason Coyle.

BCPC Appointment: A motion to approve Res 2026-09, Berks County Purchasing Council Rep appointment was unanimously approved on a motion by Ron McClure, seconded by Jason Coyle.

Stormwater Agreements: Motion to approve the stormwater agreements for 36 Glennola Drive and 50 Lindsay Ct was made by Jeff Fiant, seconded by Jason Coyle, and passed unanimously.

EMC Reports: Ron McClure presented the information on the EMC Reports.

Adjournment: Motion made by Jeff Fiant, seconded by Jason Coyle, and was unanimously approved, to adjourn the meeting at 4:26.
