

National Night Out

National Night Out enhances the relationship between neighbors and law enforcement while bringing back a true sense of community. Furthermore, it provides a great opportunity to bring police and neighbors together under positive circumstances.

Public Works

Two New Township Public Works Vehicles purchased with Grant Awards

Our road crew became better equipped to serve the township recently!

Both Grants were received through the Department of Community & Economic Development (DCED) programs. The first vehicle was awarded through the "Local Share Account Program," in which gaming revenues are distributed through the Commonwealth Financing Authority to support projects in the public interest.

Former township Secretary, Kelly Young applied for the LSA grant in 2023, and the \$64,407 grant was approved in April 2024. The monies were used to purchase a 2024 Chevrolet Silverado 2500HD Work Truck to allow our road crew to work on multiple jobs simultaneously & with less gas expense.

The second vehicle is on order; a 2025 108SD 4x4 39000 GVW Freightliner with Municipal Plow & Dump application. This much more expensive vehicle was financed through two programs,

over several years. An LSA grant (as summarized

above) was applied for with support from Senator Scott Martin in 2022 and awarded \$30,490 in March of 2023. However, since it did not cover the full cost of the project, another grant application was submitted



to the DCED through a single application to a program called "Economic Development & Community Development Initiatives" in 2024 and was awarded in March for \$200,000 to cover the rest of the cost for the large & specialized vehicle.


These projects were financed by grants from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Commonwealth Financing Authority, & Department of Community and Economic Development.

Paving Projects 2024

During May 2024, Beech Road, Sell Road, and Westley Road were repaved by New Enterprise Stone and Lime Company, Inc.

The Township's public works employees are presently working on Kremp Road, installing new pipes and preparing it for widening and paving. The actual paving work will be done later this summer by the Township's road crew, with half being done this year and half of the road being paved next year.
