A MESSAGE FROM YOUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



I recently found myself outside, kneeling in the dirt with the best of intentions to “get a jump on spring.” Armed with gloves I wasn’t sure had ever met soap, and a trowel that’s seen better days, I set out to conquer a small patch in my yard’s corner that felt as vast as the Grand Canyon—mostly because the work ahead looked just as intimidating.

That new perspective made the whole process feel a little more manageable—like finally learning that the garden will grow at its own pace regardless, even if I can’t always see it happening.

And that’s when it hit me—gardening, much like life, isn’t about perfection or instant success. It’s about showing up, doing what we can, giving our best, and finding joy in the process—even when things get messy or don’t go as planned. Sometimes those messy, imperfect moments teach us that stepping back and letting things unfold without interference is both the most difficult yet most rewarding part of the journey — and that’s beautiful!
