A MESSAGE FROM YOUR REGIONAL DIRECTOR

REMEMBERING CAROLYN GOTTS: FEARLESS AT HEART

Note: Carolyn Gotts passed away on April

5, shortly after her story was submitted by her family. We are honored to share this tribute to her remarkable life—she will be deeply missed by all who knew her.

If you wanted to know how Carolyn Gotts moved through the world, you could start at the edge of a barn rafter in Hilton, New York. Picture a farm girl with a spark in her eye and a daredevil's heart, balancing high above the hayloft just because she could. That was Carolyn: always testing her limits, always saying yes to a little adventure.

Born in 1939 in Rochester and raised on that Hilton farm by her mother and father, Carolyn grew up alongside her younger brother in the kind of childhood built for stories—roller skating whenever she could, cheering in the bleachers at basketball games, and dreaming big. It was at one of those games, in a noisy gym, where she first saw Gordon Gotts. She nudged her friend and whispered, "I'm going to marry him someday." And she did just that.

After high school, Carolyn took a job at Kodak, then married Gordon in 1958. Together, they built a marriage that spanned 68 years and a family that grew to include two children, two grandchildren and two great-grandchildren—each one a piece of her heart.

Carolyn's journey carried her far

from upstate New York, weaving through Florida, California, Colorado and eventually Georgia. No matter where she landed, she made every house a home, her hands rarely still: knitting, crocheting, macramé, or the next project that caught her fancy.

But Carolyn's real backbone was her faith—a steady, unwavering love for the Lord that shaped every day. In every community, she found her church family and dove in, starting libraries, working in thrift stores, rocking babies in the nursery. Her devotion wasn't quiet duty; it was the heartbeat of how she lived.

Alongside Gordon, she built more than a home—she built houses, real ones, from the ground up. Colorado and Florida saw her hauling drywall, stacking cinder blocks, rolling paint on fresh walls and smoothing out wallpaper seams. At age 60, when most people started slowing down, Carolyn moved to Thomasville, Georgia, built yet another house, and launched a home-flipping business for good measure. Retirement was never in her vocabulary.

Anyone who knew her would tell you: Carolyn's love for her family was fierce and boundless. Her faith was bright and contagious. She was the kind of person who said yes to life's challenges, yes to helping others and yes to the next big adventure, wherever it might lead. And if you ever wondered how far one woman's heart and hands could reach, you only needed to follow the stories—across rafters, across the country, and always, always home.

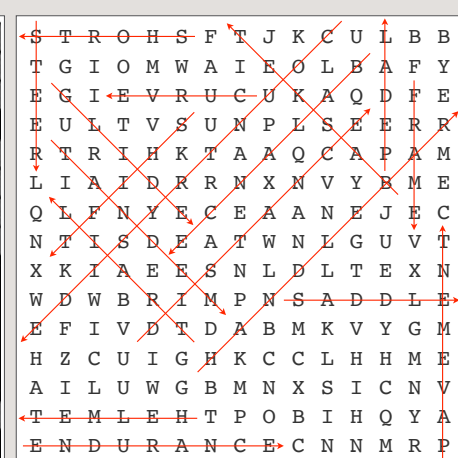
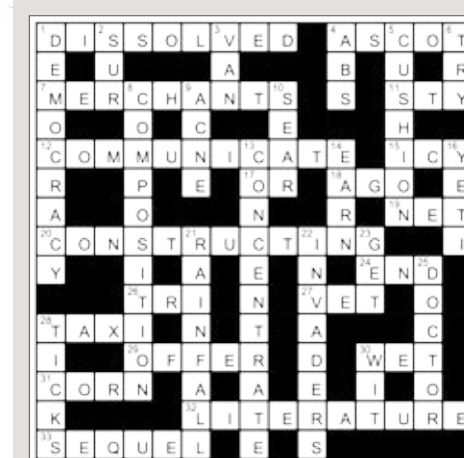

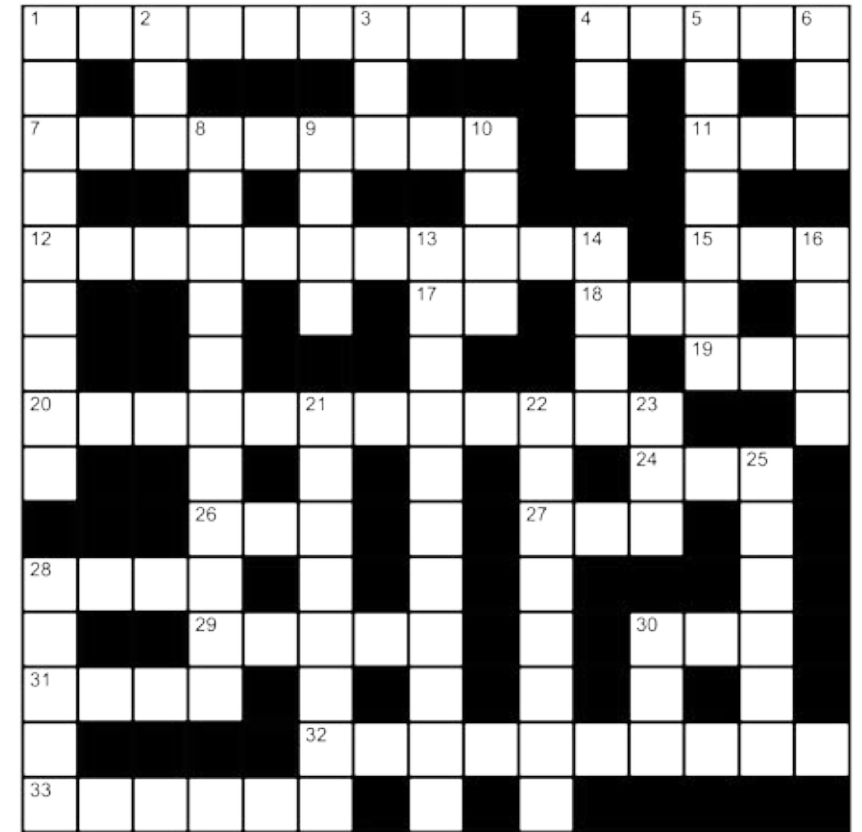
