



IMPORTANT CAMP INFORMATION

ARRIVAL: *Morning Camp* begins at 9:00am. Doors open at 8:45am. *Afternoon Camp* begins at 12:30pm. If you will be later than 15 minutes, or if your child will not be attending that day, please give us a call at 609-399-7628 so we can let the Camp Instructor know. You must sign your child in on first day of camp. Your child may sign themselves in thereafter, if necessary.

PICK UP: *Morning Camp* pick-up is at 12 noon. *Afternoon Camp* pick-up is at 3:30pm. Please provide front desk with the name of any other person authorized to pick-up your child. Only individuals whose names have been provided by you will be allowed to pick up your child. If you will be later than 15 minutes, please give us a call at 609-399-7628.

CLOTHING: Art is messy! Wear comfortable clothing that you do not mind getting paint, glue, and clay on. Most will wash out, but some markers are permanent, and even washable paint can leave a stain on light clothing.

FOOD/DRINK: There will be a short snack break during camp session. Please send your child with a bagged snack and plenty to drink. We do have a water fountain. Refrigeration and heating of food is not available. Make sure all reusable items are clearly marked for identification.

WEATHER: During summer season, there is always the possibility of severe weather closings and/or early pickup. If we determine we need to close due to severe weather, we will notify you via email and we will post a notice on our website. During severe weather, check your email before bringing your child to camp. If we need you to pick up early, we will call the main contact(s) on your registration form.

ILLNESS / COVID POLICY: Students should remain at home if exhibiting any signs of illness. Covid-19 symptoms include fever, new or persistent cough, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, fatigue, and/or stomach issues. Please inform The Art Center of any allergies, physical or dietary limitations, and/or concerns that may relate to you or your child. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to inform The Art Center of any allergies (e.g. peanuts) that would be of concern.

CANCELLATION: Please familiarize yourselves with the Arts Center's Camp Cancellation Policy. Cancellations initiated by parent/guardian are not refundable.

CAMP PICTURES: Our staff will be taking photographs of the kids during camp. The Art Center may use photographs or videos that include you or your children for publicity or marketing purposes unless you deny permission in writing.
