Jessica Mungekar is the owner and artist behind Fine Cement Craft, a sculpture studio in Southern New Jersey. Raised in Philadelphia among artists, she holds a BFA in Painting and Sculpture from the Pacific Northwest College of Art and an MSW from Temple University.

Jessica creates hand-painted hollow cement spheres ranging from 5 to 50 inches, infused with images, text, and color — works rooted in the sphere's universal symbolism and its capacity to bring quiet healing. Her work has appeared in exhibitions, public installations, and climate-resilience initiatives, including NJ Audubon's RiSC program.

A recipient of the Camden Fireworks Self-Taught Artist Grant and the NJ State Climate Resilience Public Art Award, she serves on arts boards and juries across Philadelphia and Southern NJ. Jessica is also a certified Mindful Art facilitator and currently serves as Artist-in-Residence at Rowan University (2025–2026), bringing mindful art-making to medical staff.
