TOP 5 THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

1 **THE WORSHIP EXPERIENCE**

We want your kids to look forward to coming to church every week. So, we've created a fun environment filled with prizes, games, and messages that will reflect the heart of God and help them experience the transforming power of Jesus Christ. To provide the best possible experience to your child, we ask that you arrive no later than 15 minutes from the start of service. If you arrive 15 minutes after the beginning of the service, your child will be invited to sit with you in the main worship experience.

2 **WE DO SMALL GROUPS**

Being a part of a small group allows your child to build relationships, have consistent mentoring, and learn how to apply biblical teachings to everyday life. As in any small group, consistency is key in building relationships and learning new things.

3 **WELLNESS**

We care about the health of your child and the other kids too! Therefore, we ask that all kids who are experiencing a fever of 100.0 or above, vomiting, or have started taking an antibiotic within the last 24 hours not come to class on that day. We also ask that if your child is experiencing shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, or has been exposed to anyone positively diagnosed with COVID-19, not come to class that day. Additionally, we thoroughly clean and disinfect all classroom items before and after each service.

4 **WHAT TO BRING**

Anything you bring with you should be based on the age of your child. For our older kids (K thru 5th grade), we strongly encourage them to bring their bibles. Avoid bringing personal items like toys or tablets, and due to allergies, food is not allowed.

5 **TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU**

Every week, your child will have the opportunity to take home a Family Devotion related to the lesson. This allows you to see what they learned and continue the conversation throughout the week.
