Turkey's most populated city, Istanbul, can best be described as a real-life fairytale. Mysterious, imposing structures arise around every street corner and the beautiful mosques with their many minarets give you the feeling you're walking in a famous *Tale From 1001 Nights*. Advertised by Sean Connery in 1963, with the words "*Moonlight over the Bosphorus...*", Istanbul truly is a romantic city. This did not only lead to full exposure of the city's splendour in 1963's *FROM RUSSIA WITH LOVE*, but also had Bond return (though not really) in 1999's *THE WORLD IS NOT ENOUGH* and - far more seriously - in 2012's *SKYFALL*.

CRAZY ISTANBUL FACTS:

- Istanbul is one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world.
- Istanbul straddles two continents, Europe and Asia, and is the only city in the world to do so.
- Once known as Constantinople, Istanbul was built on seven hills.
- Istanbul is the largest city in Europe.
- Although it is not the capital of Turkey, İstanbul has served as an imperial capital for over 1500 years: The city was the capital of the Eastern Roman (330-1204), Latin (1204-1261), Byzantine (1261-1453), and Ottoman (1453-1922) empires.
- Istanbul receives more snow than any other city in the Mediterranean Basin.
- Over 90% of Istanbul residents are Muslim and there are 2691 active mosques in the city.
- The Grand Bazaar is one of the oldest and largest covered markets in the world. With over 90 million annual visitors, it is considered one of the most popular attractions in the world, and some consider it one of the world's first shopping malls.
- There are hundreds of water cisterns below the city of Istanbul.
- There are hundreds of thousands of street cats in the city. In many parks and streets, people built houses for the cats.
