Declaration (Please read thoroughly before signing)

- Vehicles MUST arrive before 10.00am or will be parked in the public car park
- NO VEHICLE MOVEMENT during show hours (10am-5pm) unless instructed by a marshal.
- No Modern vehicle movement on site permitted between 10am and 5pm on show days.
- **Rally fields are likely to be on uneven ground, It is your own responsibility to ensure appropriate footwear etc is worn. We will not be held responsible for injuries etc if this is not adhered to.**
- No generating sets to be run between 10.00pm and 7.00am
- Any instructions by rally stewards/marshals **MUST** be adhered to: Failure to do so may lead to being requested to leave the site.
- Terms and conditions may be changed at any time at the discretion of the organisers
- The safety officers' word is FINAL, he has the full support of the organisers and any offenders will be dealt with accordingly.
- Drivers of any exhibit must hold a driving licence and Road Traffic Act Third Party Insurance appropriate to the class of the exhibit
- All exhibits must be on display at their designated position from 10 am to 5 pm Saturday and 10 am to 4 pm on Sunday unless prior arrangements have been made with the show organisers
- Contravention of any of the above may result in the exhibit and exhibitors being removed from the rally site
- Dog owners are legally liable for their dogs, that must be kept on a lead at all times and faeces must be cleared up immediately
- The organisers abide with the General Data Protection Regulation 2018, we do not sell, share or provide any information we hold about you to any other party. All information we hold is securely stored and only used to administer the rally and the rally programme. The full Privacy Policy is available on the website
- I confirm that my exhibit will be covered by at least a £2 million public liability insurance for the duration of the rally and, where required, it will also have the necessary insurance – tests and certificates – road tax and will only be operated by capable persons legally allowed to.
- Stationary Engines will be displayed in the Threshing area. Camping, support vehicles and trailers will not be permitted in this area.
- Unless agreed by the organisers, no SAE indicates that the terms have not been read and will therefore not be accepted.
- No camping spaces are to be reserved all tents and caravans in the engine line up are to be hidden and to be in their allocated plot boundaries and to be kept tidy and in keeping.
- Wristbands will be limited to 2 Wristbands per exhibit unless arranged prior to the show no extra wristbands will be available at the gate.
- The Organisers will not pay any surcharges for incorrect/unpaid postage.
