Carolyn's passions extend into her creative hands. She is an accomplished seamstress who delights in quilting, crafting personalized quilts and matching pillows for each of her five grandchildren. Her love for the outdoors shines through in memories of fishing and horseback riding from her younger days.

Together, Carolyn and Benny raised three children, two boys and a daughter, growing their family to fifteen grandchildren, five great-grandchildren and ten great-great-grandchildren. Reflecting on her life, Carolyn fondly describes Benny as her "rock," the steady presence supporting her through every season.

Today, Carolyn is a valued resident at Legacy Village of Jacksonville. We are grateful to know her and honored to share in this next chapter of her remarkable life.

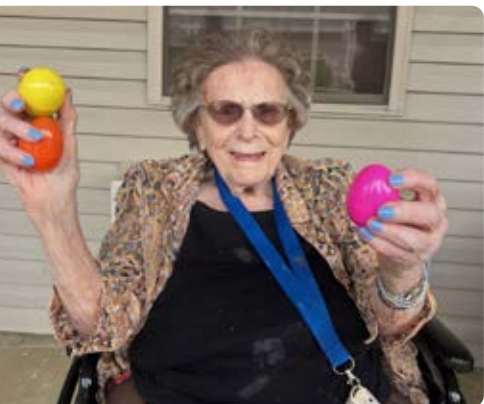

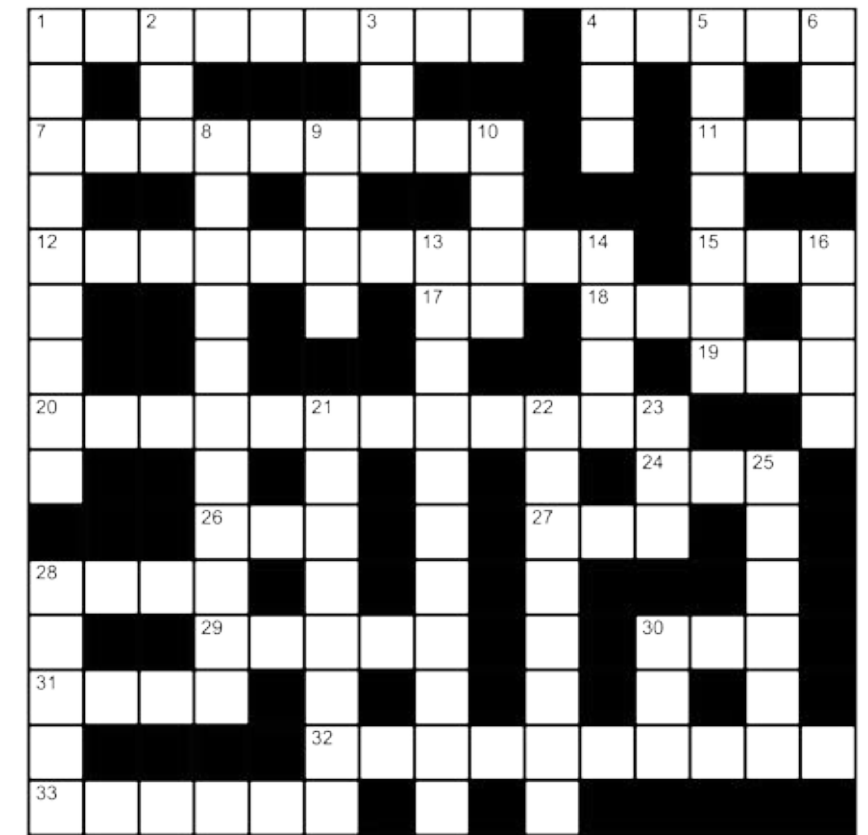
