SUB COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Financial Sub-Committee Report

The clubhouse operation has continued to run at a loss as in recent past years, it is expected there will be a marked improvement as we begin summer trading. The on-going issues with the with manager being unable to work due to injury has caused a few problems with finalising accounts but we are receiving great support from the accountant to keep things up to date.

Significant expenditure has been approved for clubhouse maintenance to correct issues with previous roof work, paint the roof, replace the spouting and complete the exterior paint work, this will mean the whole exterior of the clubhouse maintenance has been brought up to date.

The yard has been profitable this month and will pick up significantly next month when we expect it to be running at capacity. Approval has been given to purchase a further two cradles which will allow us to scrap one existing in poor condition and add one to the total available.

Building & Facilities Sub-Committee Report

Yard Manager Report:

- Email received from yard regarding member parking dinghy on wharf, an ongoing
 issue. Member not abiding by the rules for a prolonged period of time, letter to go to
 member giving him a week to rectify his behaviour and if continues to be taken to
 disciplinary. TE to draft letter to go out.
- Another Issue with liveaboard/member who has been causing issues with yard team
 with parking on jetty, anchoring off wharf with float line which has been reported to
 harbourmaster. Currently is following rules with booking wharf etc, if these are broken
 again, will have a letter sent and will be taken to disciplinary.
- All cradles full, one is being scrapped as too damaged and will keep off it what is able
 to be salvageable. Two new cradles would be ideal to purchased; they are available,
 fully galvanised. They are \$5000 each but will also need to organise delivery of them.
 Agreed by whole committee to proceed with purchase.
- 7 more boats waiting to come out at present.

Work In Progress:

- Installing of gate on Jetty is being investigated for security and trespass concerns from members. on hold for now.
- Replacement of the boards on the gangway with checkerboard plate as the current solution is not fit for purpose. To follow up with KR (AF to follow up with him). Check pricing on Aluminium replacement for cost comparison.
- Update pricing on Ramp Notice board prices to be changed.
- Look into getting a new tractor/telehandler. Can look at pricing. Budget given to look around for a new one. Research is underway, looking at a slightly better option to provide the club with a more suitable, longer-term solution for the yard.

• Gangway looking to put rubber matting over what's there and spot touch up on the rust that is there, need to source mats.

Club House report:

- SC has taken over the roster for the next few weeks.
- GW in discussion with agencies for Duty Manager to cover bigger events.
- TE to ask DD for anything organised for Sunday Sounds etc and get details to move things forward. KR & SS to look into potential acts.
- GW to speak with ID to see if stepping up to Bar manager. KR & SS to look at Sunday Sounds options.

Work In Progress:

- Overall plan for the maintenance and upgrades to all club facilities, including:
 - Working bees
 - o Painting the clubhouse
 - o Deck Quote
 - Upgrades to the inside
- Removing of excess freezers
- Looking into option to advertise club activities on the TV screens
