Training Pathway

- **Level 2 Award in Public Health**
- **Level 3 Award in Theories and Principles of Behaviour Change**
- **Level 3 Award in the Wider Determinants of Health and Health Inequalities**
- **Level 3 Award in the Roles and Responsibilities of People Supporting Health and Wellbeing**

At the end of the pathway, on completion of the relevant assessments, all participants will receive RSPH qualifications at Levels 2 and 3, as well as complimentary Associate membership of RSPH for 1 year.

Assessments must be completed by 28 November**

- Places are fully funded - 20 spaces are available on a first come basis
- Must be living or working in Buckinghamshire, Oxfordshire, or Berkshire
