This walk offers an exciting circuit of Burry Port for all Ramble & Scramble fans! Follow the dragons as they take you out to the lighthouse, the beach and then across to the RNLI Lifeboat Station!

Distance: 1.7 miles Difficulty: Leisurely Time: 1.5 hours

Activity 1 - Amelia Earhart

Look at the fingerposts - where did Amelia Earhart visit?

Which City is the nearest to you now?

Take a photo of you under the fingerposts & post on social media using #rambleandscramble






There are places to buy food & drink on the main high street across from the station



Make sure you exit the train station via the car park and walk up to the road and roundabout. Go straight over the roundabout and take care to watch for traffic.



Once you have reached the far side of the roundabout, look out for the Amelia Earhart fingerposts. It's time for your first activity!



It's now time to explore the beach! As you turn around, looking back at Burry Port, drop down to your left onto the beach for more fun activities!

Walk across the beach and take the path leading you behind the sand dunes. You are now joining the Wales Coast Path. Head to your right to follow the yellow and blue signs as they lead you back alongside the marina and then around to the other side where you'll find the RNLI Lifeboat station.

You've now got options. You can continue to explore the Wales Coast Path as it heads towards Llanelli, or you can head back to Burry Port for a drink and some cake!



Activity 2 - The Lighthouse

Why do we have lighthouses?

How many steps do you think are in the lighthouse? Maybe 20? Stomp your way around the lighthouse counting to 20!

Now stand in front of the lighthouse & look out to sea. Stretch your arms out wide and pretend you are a seagull flying out to the other lighthouse - can you spot it?
