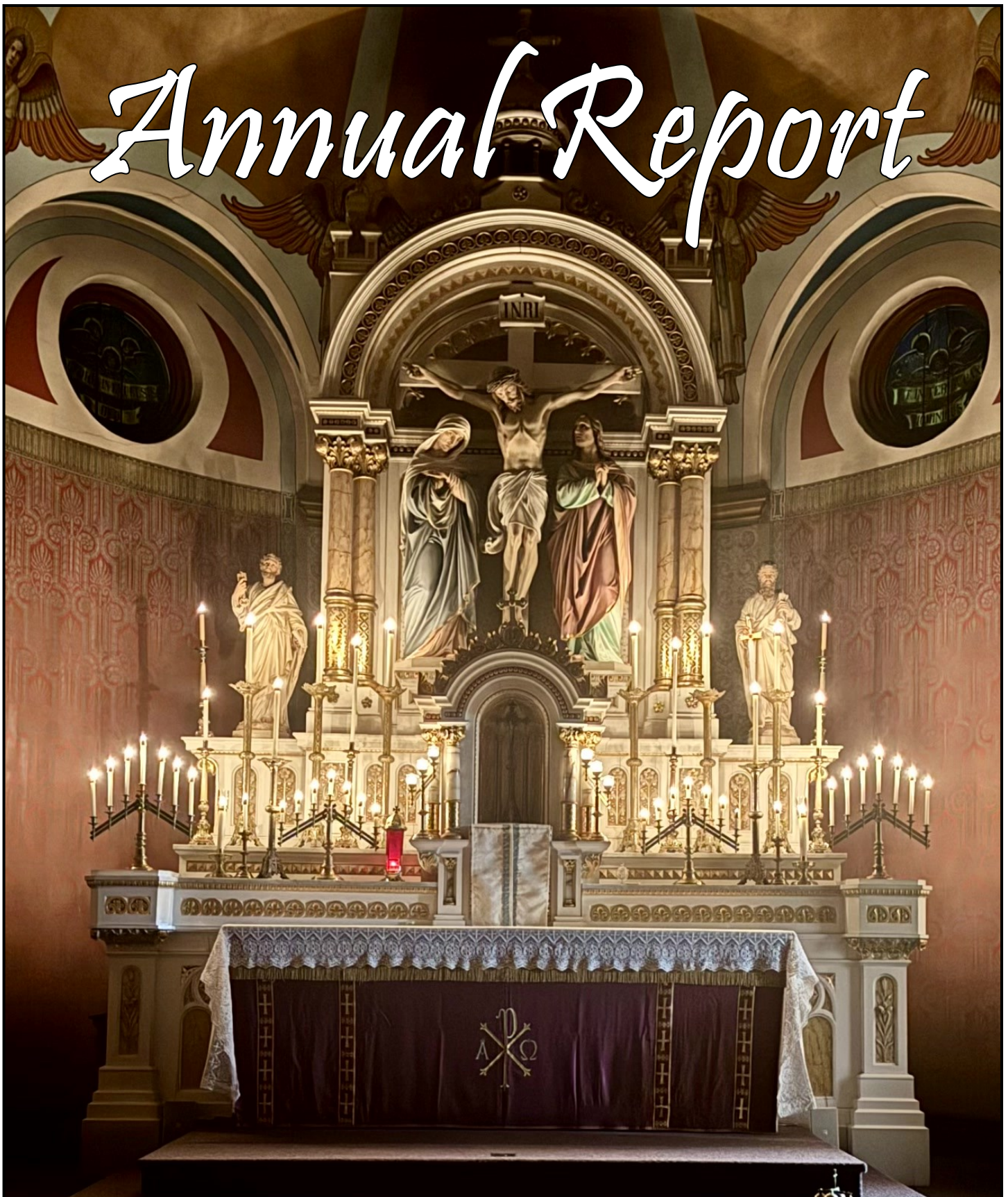

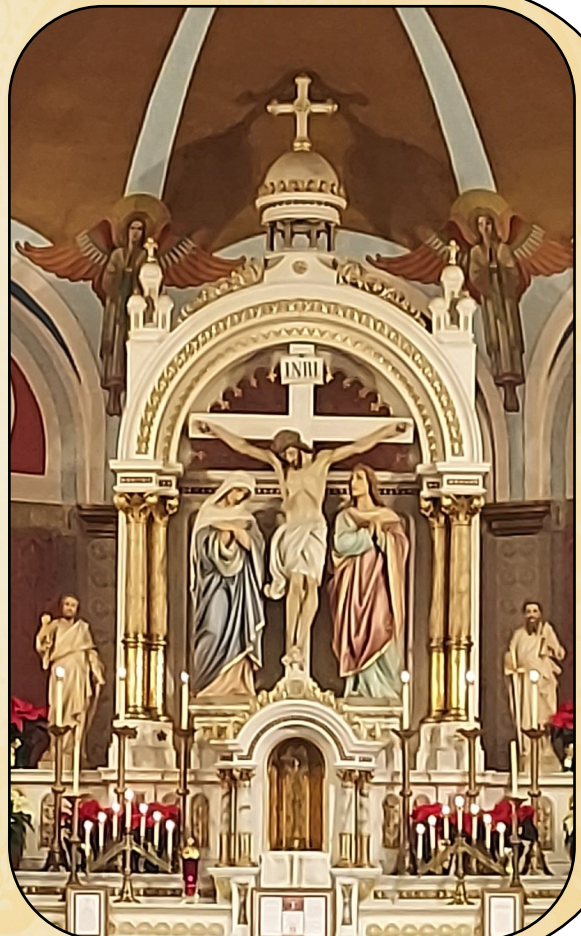
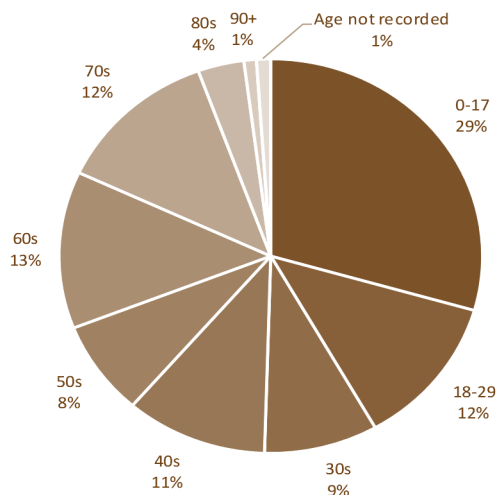

Faith Formation & Youth Ministry

Family Formation

Our parish utilizes a family formation model of faith formation for kindergarten through 5th grade. Parents attend classes at church twice a month along with their children, and teach them at home on alternate weeks, using materials and instructions provided.

Grades 6-8

This year our 6-8th grade students are studying the Sacraments and meet twice a month.

Grades 9-12

Our high school students are focusing on Morality this school year and meet twice a month.

Youth & Young Adults

Once a month during the school year, our parish offers a meal and presentation for high school youth and young adults through age 25. Guest speakers include area priests, religious, and laity.

First Communion & Confirmation

Both children and parents participate in the preparation provided for by the Religious Education staff. Classes are held Sunday mornings.

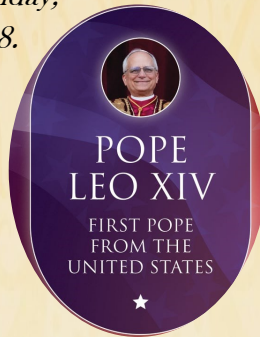
