The two were married on June 4, 1949, building a life and family together in the small farmhouse that once sat on five acres of farmland—in the same spot White Oak now stands.



As time passed and kids grew older, the land eventually became available and was purchased by Dave and Cindy Walsh Rosiello who saw all of its potential.

The White Oak barn had a similar effect on them. It was originally constructed in Navarre, Ohio, in 1838, standing tall as time and generations passed. In 2024, the barn was purchased and carefully deconstructed for travel to its new home in the rolling hills of Morgantown, where it was meticulously reassembled and updated as needed, becoming the unwavering foundation of what was still to come. Reclaimed hemlock barn wood siding was added, full of

texture and color that perfectly complements the white oak frame. Large rustic chandeliers hang from the ceiling, casting a soft glow over the indoor space. Throughout, you will find artifacts and antiques tastefully worked into the structure and decor for a nostalgic reminder of the barn's rich history. Rustic charm meets modern elegance with rich black, white, and gold details as well as clean lines and neutral tones to create a timeless look. Outside, a stamped concrete pad tucked among beautifully designed landscaping opens up opportunities for outdoor ceremonies.

Opened in October 2025, White Oak 1838 is Morgantown's newest wedding and event space, and its team of professionals is dedicated to helping couples master the full wedding experience from start to finish—all tailored to their own unique stories.
