

FAQ

Q: Do I have to have a **Driver's License** or **Learner's Permit** to do the Behind The Wheel Training?

A: **Yes**, you must have a **Valid Driver's License**, or an **Active Learner's Permit** from any state or foreign country. If not, please obtain a Learner's Permit from your local DMV, then reach out to us at: 704-360-8888 to schedule an appointment.

Q: Do I have to take the Driver's Education Class to get a Driver's License or Learner's Permit?

A: If you are **under 18 years of age, yes**, you must take the 30 hours of Driver's Ed Class, to obtain your Lerner's Permit. If you are **over 18 years or older, no**.

Q: Is there an age requirement to take the Driver's Education Online Class?

A: Yes, the student must be **(14 ½ - 17 years old)** to take the Driver's Education Online Class.

Q: If I am over 18 years old, can I just do the Behind The Wheel training?

A: Yes, If you are over 18 years old, you can schedule sessions for Behind The Wheel Training.

Q: How can I schedule **Behind The Wheel training** with an instructor?

A: Please click on the **BOOK NOW** button to schedule an appointment with an instructor. Please refer to the website and choose the appropriate training session and date/time on the calendar.

Q: How long is the Driver's Education Online Class?

A: The Driver's Education Online Class is scheduled for **two weeks, Monday – Friday, 4:00pm to 7:00pm**. Please see the Teen Education page for specific dates. (Dates are subject to change)

Q: What is included in the **Teen Education Program**?

A: 30 Hours of Online Classroom Instruction **AND** 3 Sessions Behing The Wheel.

Q: Is there a difference between Driver's Education and Driver's training?

A: Yes, **Driver's Education is for Online Classroom Instruction**, and **Driver's Training is for driving Behind The Wheel** of the vehicle.

Q: How long is each session of the **Behind The Wheel training**?

A: Sessions are 1 ½ hour minimum and 2 hours maximum. Please schedule accordingly.

Q: Do you offer a **refresher class for Adults** to obtain their Learner's Permit / Driver's License?

A: **Yes**, we offer tools and questions to study.

Q: Can we use the driving school vehicle to do the road test at the DMV?

A: **Yes**, the fee is \$175.00.

Q: **What type of payments do you accept?**

A: We accept **Zelle, Check, or Money Order**. Once you book your appointment online, you can pay through **Zelle**. If you choose to pay by **check**, or **money order**, the payment will be collected during your first scheduled appointment.
