## **MOST FREQUENTLY USED RESOURCES:**

- <u>Addison Township</u> 630-530-8161 serves Elmhurst residents north of North Ave. Food Pantry and limited financial assistance (must be income eligible).
- CAP (Christians Against Poverty) 888-777-4620 debt advice, budgeting, financial health counseling.
- <u>Catholic Charities</u> 630-495-8008 Provides rental, food, transportation, medication, clothing assistance to those with demonstrated need. A Coordinated Entry System site to help homeless get into housing.
- <u>DuPage County Information and Resources</u> dial 211 for health and social services resources. 211 is a three-digit telephone number that is available 24/7 and 365 days per year.
- <u>Elmhurst Walk-In Assistance Network</u> 630-782-6006, St Peter's Church of Christ, 125 W. Church St, Elmhurst. Assists Elmhurst residents, school families, and participating church members with car repair, food, clothing voucher, household goods voucher, medical, rent, transportation, and utility bill assistance.

- <u>Hands and Feet Outreach</u> 630-832-5580, St. Paul's Lutheran Church, 537 S. Ardmore, Villa Park. Open 1st Sunday of month 2-4PM. Household goods, toiletries and shoes. DuPage residents must show ID.
- <u>LIHEAP</u> (Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program) 1-800-942-9412, utility bill assistance (primarily heating). Reconnection Assistance. Apply at York Township or Addison Township.
- <u>LOVE Christian Clearing House</u> 630-512-8665. Provides rental, car repair, and utilities assistance. Clients must have income. To start, call and leave a message.
- <u>Outreach House</u> 630-693-0185, 805 S. Main, Lombard. Assist with food, clothes, infant needs, utility bills (shut off notice required). Residents of York Township, Glendale Heights and Addison are eligible.
