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Regular Opportunities for Prayer and Worship

Holy Eucharist (Mass)

Sundays at 8:00am and 10:30am

Holy Eucharist is the principle service of community worship at St. Peter's. In Catholic circles it is called, Mass; in Protestant circles it is called Holy Communion or the Lord's Supper. Our Sunday Eucharist at 8:00am is a quiet, spoken service with no music and uses Elizabethan English. Our Sunday Eucharist at 10:30am includes hymns, anthems, and a choir.

Family Eucharist (Mass)

Last Sunday of the Month at 10:30am

Every last Sunday of the month is Family Sunday at St. Peter's, our most attended service of the month. Our 10:30am Eucharist is adapted to be especially inclusive of younger members, and the service includes a children's homily.

Morning and Evening Prayer

Weekdays at 8:00am & 5:15pm

Every weekday at St. Peter's we observe Morning Prayer (Matins) and Evening Prayer (Vespers), a beautiful tradition from *The Book of Common Prayer*. The liturgies include readings from Scripture, a Psalm, appointed prayers, as well as moments of silence and opportunities for personal prayer.

Evensong- Each Wednesday Evening Prayer will be sung with hymns.

Major Feast Days (Mass)

Various Weekdays at 8:00am

On Major Feast Days (special celebrations of the church), in place of Morning Prayer will be a service of Holy Eucharist (mass) at 8:00am. Upcoming Major Feast Days include: the Transfiguration of Our Lord (Aug 6); St. Mary the Virgin, Mother of Our Lord (Aug 14, Trans.), St. Bartholomew (Aug 24), the Holy Cross (Sept. 14), St. Matthew (Sept. 21), St. Michael and All Angels (Sept. 29), St. Luke (Oct. 18), St. James of Jerusalem (Oct. 23), Sts. Simon and Jude (Oct. 28), All Souls (Oct. 31, Trans.), All Saints (Nov. 1), St. Andrew (Nov. 30), St. Thomas (Dec. 21), the Nativity of Our Lord (Dec. 24 & 25), Holy Innocents (Dec. 28), and the Holy Name (Jan. 1).

Centering Prayer

Weekdays at 7:30am

Centering Prayer is a form of silent Christian meditation in which we let go of our reflections and thoughts in order to rest in the presence of God. You can ask Fr. Derek for more information about the method, or simply come and pray in silence.

Private Prayer in the Church

Weekdays from 7:30am-5:45pm

The Church is open for private prayer every weekday. Whether you have a few moments before a doctor's appointment, are passing by on your way to the store, or need some quiet time away from the kids, the church is open for you.



Special Opportunities for Prayer and Worship

Blessing of the Backpacks

Sunday, August 9, 2026

We invite students, teachers, and all who work in education to come forward with their backpack or school supplies for a special blessing for the beginning of the year. The blessing will be offered at both services. In addition we will also be blessing the school supplies we collected to donate to local school students.

Blessing of the Animals

Sunday, October 4, 2026 at 4:00pm

Every year around the Feast Day of St. Francis we offer a special outdoor liturgy for the blessing of animals. Bring your pets or farm animals for this short liturgy as we give thanks for their presence in our lives. Please keep animals on leashes or contained. You may also bring donations for our pet supply pantry.

Blessing of the Oil of the Sick

Sunday, October 18, 2026

On the Sunday closest to the Feast of St. Luke (Oct. 18), we bless the Oil of the Sick, used for the Sacrament of Holy Unction, or the anointing those who are ill with holy oil. The blessing will take place at both services and prayers for healing will be offered during communion.

All Souls Requiem Mass

Saturday, October 31, 2026 at 9:00am

Join us as we observe the Feasts of All Souls for a Eucharist service outside in the Memorial Garden to commemorate those in our lives who have died in hope of the resurrection. We invite you to bring flowers and/or photographs of your loved ones as we give thanks to God for our loved ones and pray for their eternal glory.

All Saints' Sunday

Sunday, November 1, 2026

On All Saints' Sunday we celebrate the whole communion of saints, known and unknown, often with baptisms. We also read aloud at the altar the names of those in our community who have died in the past year, the necrology, at both masses.

Prayer and Worship in Advent and Christmas

Lessons and Carols

Sunday, December 20, 2026 at 4:00pm

Lessons and Carols is a beloved service that originated at King's College, Cambridge in 1918 and has since become a cherished tradition around the world. Through a series of Scripture readings ("lessons") and carols sung by choir and congregation, the service tells the sweeping story of God's love—from creation and the prophets to the birth of Jesus. ***New this year, this special liturgy will take place in the afternoon followed by a Yultide Tea with Music in the parish hall.***

Longest Night Evening Prayer

Monday, December 21, 2026

For many suffering grief and loss, the holiday season is not so joyful. Perhaps it can even be painful. This quiet evening prayer liturgy at 5:15pm honors the experience of loss and offers comfort to those who mourn on the longest night of the year.

Carol Sing and Special Music

Christmas Eve at 4:30pm

As a prelude to our Festive Eucharist with Children's Pageant, join us in church as we sing Christmas carols and hear special music and anthems to brighten our spirits, awaken hope, and prepare us for the celebration of the Nativity of our Lord.

Festive Eucharist and Pageant

Christmas Eve at 5:00pm

Our first celebration of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ is a festive Eucharist designed especially for families. It begins with a children's Christmas pageant, includes readings from Scripture, a homily, and holy communion, and concludes with the candle light singing of Silent Night.

Solemn Midnight Mass

Christmas Eve at 10:30pm

Our celebration of the Nativity of our Lord continues with a traditional Midnight Mass with carols, special music, Scripture readings, homily, holy communion, and a candle light singing of Silent Night. The service includes incense.

Christmas Holy Eucharist

Christmas Day at 10:30am

A spoken mass with no music will be offered Christmas morning.

"It's Still Christmas" Family Mass

December 27, 2026

Join us on the third day of Christmas at 10:30am as we continue our celebration of the birth of Christ for a special and playful Family Eucharist with children's homily at 10:30am. There will be a regular, spoken mass at 8:00am.
