# Regular Opportunities for Prayer and Worship

## **Holy Eucharist (Mass)**

#### Sundays at 8:00am and 10:30am

Holy Eucharist is the principle service of community worship at St. Peter's. In Catholic circles it is called, Mass; in Protestant circles it is called Holy Communion or the Lord's Supper. Our Eucharist on Sundays at 8:00am is a quiet, spoken service with no music and uses Elizabethan English. Our Eucharist on Sundays at 10:30am includes hymns, anthems, and a choir. Some of the prayers are sung rather than spoken. This is our most attended service.

## Family Eucharist (Mass) Last Sunday of the Month at 10:30am

Every last Sunday of the month is Family Sunday at St. Peter's, our most attended service of the month. Our 10:30am Eucharist is adapted to be especially inclusive of younger members, and the service includes a children's homily.

## **Morning Prayer (Matins)**

#### Weekdays at 8:00am

This prayer service takes place at St. Peter's each morning and lasts about 30 minutes. It includes readings from Scripture, a Psalm, appointed prayers, as well as moments of silence and opportunities for personal prayer. The service is part of the Daily Office, four services from *The Book of Common Prayer* for Christians to pray at different times of the day inspired by monasticism and the early Church. We will offer an instructed Morning Prayer to explain the liturgy on Monday, August 18th.

## **Compline**

#### Wednesdays at 6:50pm

Compline is a ten minute service of prayer for nighttime held in the church after our Wednesday community dinner (Engage Cafe) at 6:50pm. It includes the singing of a hymn and is led by our choir members.

## Centering Prayer

#### Weekdays at 7:30am

Centering Prayer is a form of silent Christian meditation in which we let go of our reflections and thoughts in order to rest in the presence of God. You can ask Fr. Derek for more information about the method, or simply come and pray in silence.

## Private Prayer in the Church Weekdays from 7:30am-5:30pm

The Church is open for private prayer every weekday. Whether you have a few moments before a doctor's appointment, are passing by on your way to the store, or need some quiet time away from the kids, the church is open for you.



## Special Opportunities for Prayer and Worship

## Blessing of the Backpacks

### Sunday, August 10, 2025

We invite students, teachers, and all who work in education to come forward with their backpack or school supplies for a special blessing for the beginning of the year. The blessing will be offered at both services. In addition we will also be blessing the school supplies we collected to donate to local school students.

## **Bishop's Visitation**

#### Sunday, September 21, 2025

Every year or two our bishop joins us in person at St. Peter's to offer a pastoral message, celebrate the Eucharist, and confirm and receive people into the Episcopal Church. We also spend some time with the bishop between services and have a reception after the 10:30am service. This year the bishop is joining us on his birthday! If you are interested in confirmation or being received into the Episcopal Church, please reach out to Fr. Derek.

### **Transitus of St. Francis**

#### Friday, October 3, 2025 at 6:00pm

Join us as we celebrate the beloved St. Francis as we commemorate his death with this creative Eucharist that includes short dramatic plays featuring our own parishioners as actors and special music. You may also get an almond cookie, Francis' favorite! A love offering will be taken up for the mission and ministry of our parish. We encourage you to invite your friends and family!

## Blessing of the Animals Sunday, October 5, 2025 at 4:00pm

Every year around the Feast Day of St. Francis we offer a special outdoor liturgy for the blessing of animals. Bring your pets or farm animals for this short liturgy as we give thanks for their presence in our lives. Please keep animals on leashes or containted.

## Blessing of the Oil of the Sick sunday, October 19, 2025

On the Sunday closest to the Feast of St. Luke (Oct. 18), we bless the Oil of the Sick, used for the Sacrament of Holy Unction, or the anointing those who are ill with holy oil. The blessing will take place at both services and prayers for healing will be offered during communion.

## All Souls Requiem Mass saturday, November 1, 2025 at 9:00am

Join us as we observe the Feasts of All Saints and All Souls for a Eucharist service outside in the Memorial Garden to commemorate those in our lives who have died in hope of the resurrection. We invite you to bring flowers and/or photographs of your loved ones as we give thanks to God for our loved ones and pray for their eternal glory.

## All Saints' Sunday

#### Sunday, November 2, 2025

On All Saints' Sunday we celebrate the whole communion of saints, known and unknown, often with baptisms. We also read aloud at the altar the names of those in our community who have died in the past year, the necrology, at both masses.





# Prayer and Worship in Advent and Christmas

## Lessons and Carols Sunday, December 14, 2025 at 10:30am

Lessons and Carols is a beloved service that originated at King's College, Cambridge in 1918 and has since become a cherished tradition around the world. Through a series of Scripture readings ("lessons") and carols sung by choir and congregation, the service tells the sweeping story of God's love—from creation and the prophets to the birth of Jesus. There will be no Holy Communion at this service, however the sacrament will be offered that day at the 8:00am mass.

## Carol Sing and Special Music Christmas Eve at 4:30pm

As a prelude to our Festive Eucharist with Children's Pageant, join us in church as we sing Christmas carols and hear special music and anthems to brighten our spirits, awaken hope, and prepare us for the celebration of the Nativity of our Lord.

## Festive Eucharist and Pageant Christmas Eve at 5:00pm

Our first celebration of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ is a festive Eucharist designed especially for families. It begins with a children's Christmas pageant, includes readings from Scripture, a homily, and holy communion, and concludes with the candle light singing of Silent Night.

## Carol Sing and Special Music Christmas Eve at 10:00pm

As a prelude to our Solemn Midnight Mass, join us in church as we sing Christmas carols and hear special music and anthems to prepare us for the celebration of the Nativity of our Lord of Jesus Christ.

## Solemn Midnight Mass Christmas Eve at 10:30pm

Our celebration of the Nativity of our Lord continues with a traditional Midnight Mass with carols, special music, Scripture readings, homily, holy communion, and a candle light singing of Silent Night. The service includes incense.

## Christmas Holy Eucharist Christmas Day at 10:30am

A spoken mass with no music will be offered Christmas morning.

## "It's Still Christmas" Family Mass December 28, 2025

Join us on the fourth day of Christmas at 10:30am as we continue our celebration of the birth of Christ for a special and playful Family Eucharist with children's homily. There will be no 8:00am mass on this day.

# Opportunities for Children and Youth Faith Formation

## **Toddlers Sunday School**

## **Laundry Love**

## **Empty Bowls for the Food Bank**

#### **November 8, 2025**

Each year the United Food Bank of Plant City hosts the Empty Bowls project as a fundraiser for its continued mission. The Food Bank sells tickets for the event which includes a soup meal, live music, and a live auction of artfully crafted bowls. Many St Peter's parishioners participate in the cooking of soup and attending. The event is located at McCall Park in Downtown Plant city from 10:00am-1:00pm. And remember that St. Peter's collects food donations for the food bank all year long at each door to the church and in Bender Hall.

## Meals on Wheels Collection October 19 - December 15, 2025

For more than 18 years, St. Peter's has put together personal care gift baskets for 40-50 recipients of Meals on Wheels during the Christmas season. We begin collecting items October 19<sup>th</sup> and deliver the baskets on December 15<sup>th</sup>.

## Thanksgiving Baskets

November 1 - November 20, 2025 St. Peter's collects items to distribute more than 20 Thanksgiving meals to families

of children at five local schools. We will be collecting items from November 1-20.

## **Angel Tree Drive**

#### November 29 - December 14, 2025

Every year our parish provides gifts for 30 children from local schools through donations from parishioners. A Christmas tree is placed in the church with angel shaped descriptions of each child. The Angel Tree will go up November 29th and gifts are due back to the church by December 14th.
