Our acting classes will give you a warm, fun, supportive environment in which you can explore acting technique and method, including speech and movement. Using age-appropriate material as you take on various roles, you will begin to understand the importance of character building. You will be guided in developing the skills and the self-awareness it takes to play your role confidently, no matter what it may be.

USE YOUR OUTSIDE VOICE... INSIDE

Explore your love of music in classes designed especially for developing young voices. Through vocal selections, you'll be introduced to vocal technique and music theory in a warm, nurturing environment that emphasizes the fun and joy of learning. You will gain the confidence and self-awareness to let your own beautiful voice ring out.
