All Saints Pastorate Missionary Internship

Dates of Internship:

Internship will begin on Monday, June 1st, and will conclude on Friday, July 31st. Interns will have the week of the 4th of July off (8 weeks total).

Hours of Internship:

Typically 35-40 hours per week, with some evening and weekend events throughout the summer. The goal is to have 300 hours completed by the end of the internship.

Compensation:

Interns will receive compensation of \$3,500.00 for the duration of the internship.

Job Description:

The All Saints Pastorate summer Missionary Internship is a Catholic missionary formation program for young adults/college students. It seeks to respond to Bishop DeGrood's vision of *Forming Lifelong Catholic Missionary Disciples Through God's Love* first by providing intensive discipleship formation opportunities for the interns while also allowing the interns opportunities to "go make disciples" through parish outreach and evangelization programs, one-on-one discipleship, small group ministry, and more. To accomplish this, we emphasize devotion and love for Our Lord in the Eucharist and Mary our Mother, catechetical instruction and deep formation in discernment and prayer.

This is a leadership position, the right candidate will be tasked with planning events for the parish, working to advertise events, communicating with key volunteers and businesses, keeping business records and budgeting, as well as being an effective teacher. A successful candidate will have basic knowledge of the skills listed above, but will have the ability to advance their proficiency in these skills in a real world setting.

Job Duties:

Interns will work closely with the Evangelization and Discipleship office at St. Thomas More to bring the Good News to parishioners of the All Saints Pastorate throughout the summer. They will aid parish leaders to help plan, organize, and conduct parish and pastorate-wide events for all ages. This internship is designed to form young people spiritually, develop their understanding of parish ministry, and foster professional development in a Catholic setting. Throughout the summer, interns will be allowed time for a daily holy hour, intentional spiritual

mentorship, time to discern the voice of the Lord, and numerous opportunities to make strategic plans for effective evangelization.

A major component of this internship will be creating, planning, and facilitating the Agnus Dei program. Agnus Dei is a summer faith formation program that is offered at the parishes in the All Saints Pastorate. This program seeks to teach young people the faith, how to pray, and live the Christian life. There are also games, skits, and songs that are incorporated in the program. A successful candidate will have the skills, or desire to grow in the skills, of sharing the faith during the Agnus Dei program.

Applicant Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years of age and graduated from High School
- Must be a practicing Catholic
- Must be Confirmed
- A basic working knowledge of the Catholic Faith
- A heart for mission and working with young people
- A valid driver's license
- **Must** have availability for the scheduled events throughout the summer

We are also seeking applicants who have and want to grow in—these qualities:

- Strong interpersonal, written, and electronic communication skills
- Working knowledge of Canva, social media platforms and google softwares (gmail, docs, sheets)
- Creativity (we want bright ideas!)
- Self-motivation
- Ability to work on a team and be led
- Desire to grow closer to the Lord and strengthen prayer life.
