

Family of the Week: Joshua and his Household

"As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord." Joshua 24:15

Every family passes something on to the next generation. It could be a tradition, a value, a way of loving, or a faith that remains alive over the years. The Bible shows us that the greatest legacies don't happen by chance; they begin when we choose to put God at the center of our home.

LEGACY BOX – Our Time Capsule

This week, your family will create a Legacy Box, a time capsule that will be opened during Family Month 2027.

Choose a box and decorate it together. Make this moment an opportunity to talk, dream, and thank God for all He has done in your home. Then, write a letter to be opened next year. In it, include how you wish to find your family a year from now, what dreams you hope to fulfill, what prayers you wish to see answered, and what values you want to strengthen in your home. You can also put inside the box: a family photo, drawings made by the children, a special verse, reasons for gratitude, prayer requests, and a keepsake that represents this moment.

FAMILY CONVERSATION

Before writing the letter, discuss these questions:

- What is a family memory we never want to forget?
- Why are we most grateful to God today?
- How do we want our family to be during the next Family Month?
- What habit do we want to develop together during this coming year?
- What do we want to be part of our family history by 2027?
- Which verse represents our heart's desire for our home?

Listen to each other carefully. Often, the simplest conversations become the most precious memories.

LET'S BUILD OUR LEGACY

Now it's time to write the letter. Share your dreams, the prayers you wish to see answered, the values you want to strengthen, and what you hope to celebrate when you open this box again.

If you need inspiration, think about attitudes you want to cultivate during this coming year: more time together, more moments of prayer, more love, more forgiveness, more patience, more laughter, more generosity, more faith, more unity.

Then, place the letter inside the Legacy Box and entrust this coming year to God, trusting that He will continue to write a beautiful story for your family.

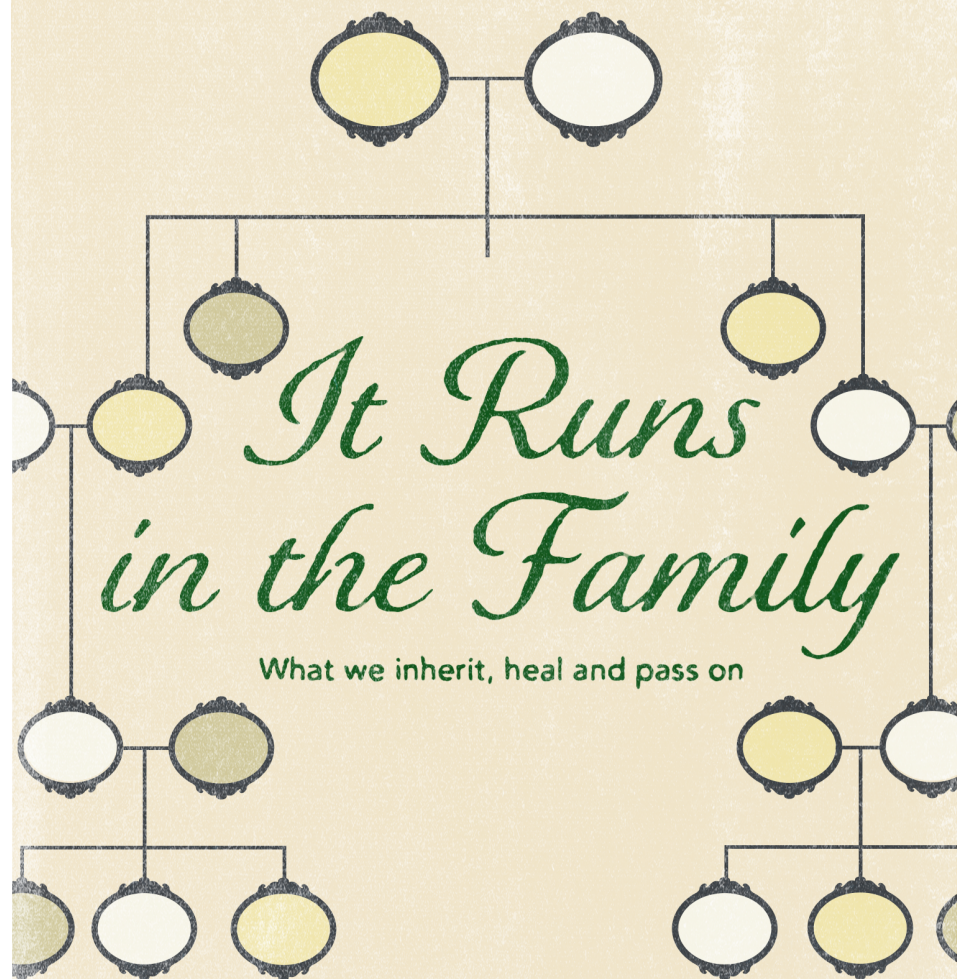
