



Thrive Series: Tame Your Chaos – Week 3

Theme: Partnership for a Breakthrough – From Survival (Manna) to Thriving (Promised Land)

Key Truths to Remember:

1. Manna = daily miracle for survival; limited, temporary, teaches dependence (Ex. 16).
2. Promised land = abundance through partnership; obedience + God's blessing (Josh. 5:12).
3. We own our part (obedience, stewardship); God multiplies (Psalm 1:3; Gal. 6:7–9).
4. We must tame chaos in three areas: Internal (emotions/mind), External (practical/finances/habits), Spiritual (devotion/faith).

Reflection Questions (Journal privately or discuss in group):

- *Identify your wilderness:* Where are you still in “manna mode” (surviving day-to-day, waiting for miracles)? (Internal / External / Spiritual)
- *See the promised land:* What would thriving look like in that area? (e.g., renewed mind/forgiveness; disciplined finances/habits; consistent devotion)
- *Own your part:* What one act of obedience/step of responsibility can you take this week to partner with God? (Be SMART: Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Time-bound.)
Example: “Every evening, journal one thing I’m grateful for and pray for renewed thoughts.”
- *Evaluate honestly:* Looking at the past month: “Was my obedience ‘good’ enough to replicate?” What pattern do I want to keep/change/stop?
- *Multiplication principle:* How might God multiply this one step of obedience (Psalm 1:3)? Pray Matthew 6:33 over it.

Prayer Commitment:

“Lord, I own my part in obedience. Equip me with wisdom and strength. Transition me from survival to thriving in partnership with You. Amen.”
