Seeking to put God's love into action, Habitat for Humanity brings people together to build homes, communities and hope.


Our Vision

Avg. Monthly Mortgage Payment in 2023: \$531.16



Homeownership Eligibility Requirements



1. Need for better housing?

 Are they living in run down or overcrowded conditions, or housing burdened?

2. Willingness to partner?

- Complete homeownership classes
- Complete sweat equity volunteer hours

3. Ability to pay?

- Family income must meet income guidelines (30 80% Annual Median Income)
- Purchase home with a 0% interest mortgage
- Make on-time payments

4. Live where we work?

Family willing to live in the neighborhoods Habitat is currently revitalizing



Spruce-Ups

Neighborhood Spruce-Up Days

- A day with 75+ volunteers working together on minor exterior repairs, landscaping, and debris removal in the neighborhood.
- Since 2013, Habitat has impacted 533 total properties through Neighborhood Spruce-Up Days
- In 2024, Habitat impacted 27 total properties in the Buckeye-Woodhill and Mt. Pleasant neighborhoods.





Critical Home Repair


Critical Home Repair Program

- In 2023, we launched our Critical Home Repair program.
- This program will provide much needed exterior repairs including roofing, gutters, siding, windows, and minor porch repairs for eligible members of the community.
- Since the start of this program, 70+ projects have been completed.






Neighborhoods of Focus






Mt. Pleasant Neighborhood




Site of 10 newly built Habitat Homes






E. 143rd Home Design


Meet Simon and Family Our 2025 Faith Build Homebuyer

- Up to 24 on Thursdays
 UP to 16 on Saturdays

- Wear closed-toed puncture and slip-resistant shoes. Comfortable clothes that you don't mind getting dirty!






Faith Engagement
