Children's After School Collection (January—February)

Neighbors Who Care Program (March—April)

Through your generosity, the following churches/centers/individuals received food, household items (paper towels, soaps, etc) and gift cards: **32 St. Raph***ael neighbors* along with 29 Easter baskets 5 families at Our *Lady of*



Mount Carmel, and 15 Easter baskets 4 families at St.
Aloysius, and 6 Easter baskets. The preschool received 24 Easter baskets and 30 bags of candy for the Easter meal. St. Malachi Center received 27-30 of each food items including cereal, pasta & sauce, pb & j, soup, cans of vegetables & fruit, mac & cheese, etc, house-hold items and 60 baskets.
