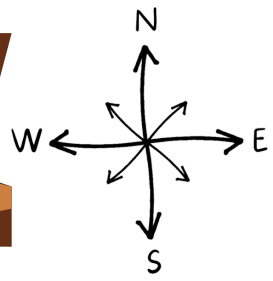

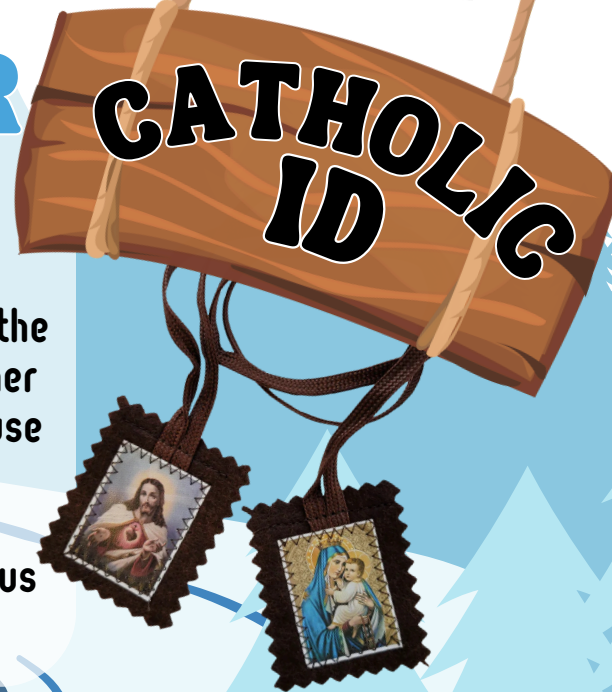


Matthew 8:5-13

BROWN SCAPULAR

Today we learned about the Brown Scapular, also known as the Scapular of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. It is a sign of devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary and reminds us of her love and protection. It is worn around the neck and is made from two pieces of cloth joined together by two strings or cords. Mary's prayer is powerful because she is so very close to her son, Jesus, who loves and listens to her.

When we feel powerless, we can trust Mary to pray for us and ask her son Jesus to help us!



SAINT MAURICE

Today we learned about Saint Maurice.

St. Maurice was from Egypt and became an officer in the Roman army. He was a Christian at the time when many people were imprisoned or hurt for following Jesus. He led a legion of soldiers who were also Christian. When the emperor ordered Maurice and his men to fight a group of Christians, they refused, even though it meant he would be killed.

Now, St. Maurice lives in eternal peace with God in Heaven. Saint Maurice reminds us that when we feel powerless, we can trust Jesus.
