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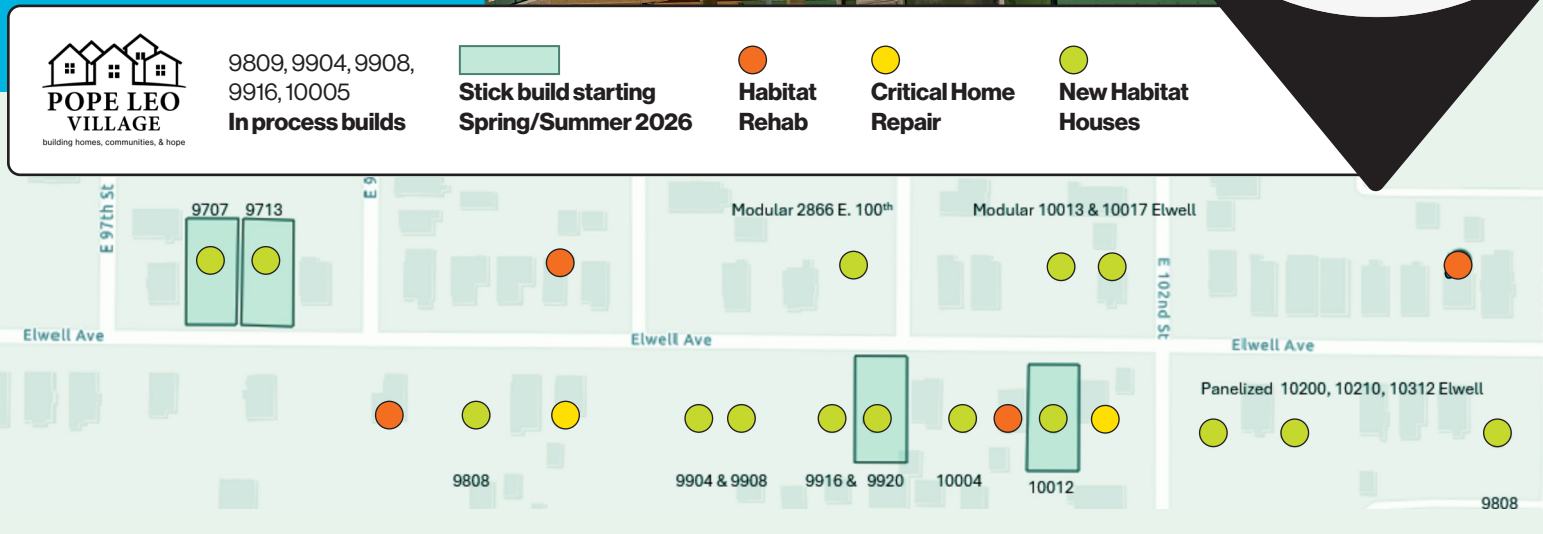
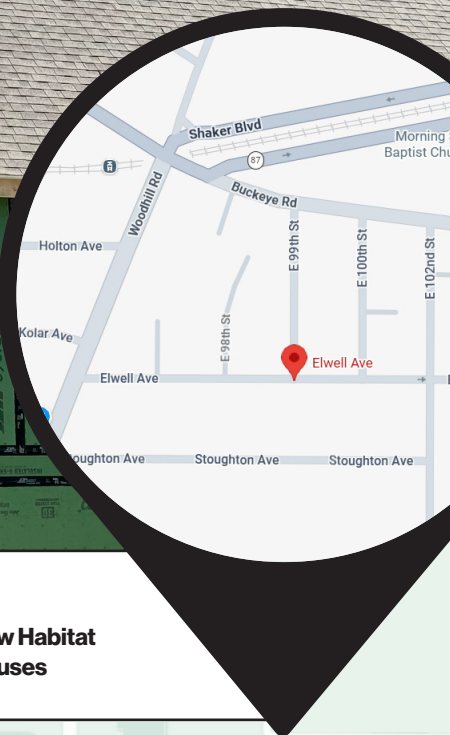
Building Stronger Neighborhoods, One Street at a Time

Greater Cleveland Habitat for Humanity has been active in the Buckeye-Woodhill neighborhood since 2016, focusing on concentrated areas rather than scattered sites to create deeper, more lasting change. **Working alongside residents, local nonprofits, and companies, we help drive real neighborhood revitalization.**

In 2025, we began work on Elwell Avenue, home to Pope Leo Village. The street already includes four Habitat families in homes we previously rehabbed, and now we're adding 15 more as the village takes shape. Of those 15 homes, six are part of the City of Cleveland's Off-Site Construction Pilot, using modular and panelized construction and completing in 2026. Five stick-built homes are currently under construction, with the remaining four breaking ground in late spring and completing in 2027.

Our Work in Buckeye & Mount Pleasant

- **48+ homes rehabbed** in Buckeye-Woodhill and Mount Pleasant
- **100+ residents supported** through **critical home repairs**
- **345+ residents** engaged through Spruce-Up **volunteer days**
- **40 new homes built** on four consecutive streets



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
