


Mission Statement

- Monthly payments are less than 30% of monthly income

- These volunteers will be lead volunteers on the 6th




What the Homes Look Like




- new construction


- Elwell Avenue in the Buckeye-Woodhill Neighborhood

History


- Habitat rehabbed & sold 4 vacant homes 2023/2024
