### **Church Picnic June 28th**

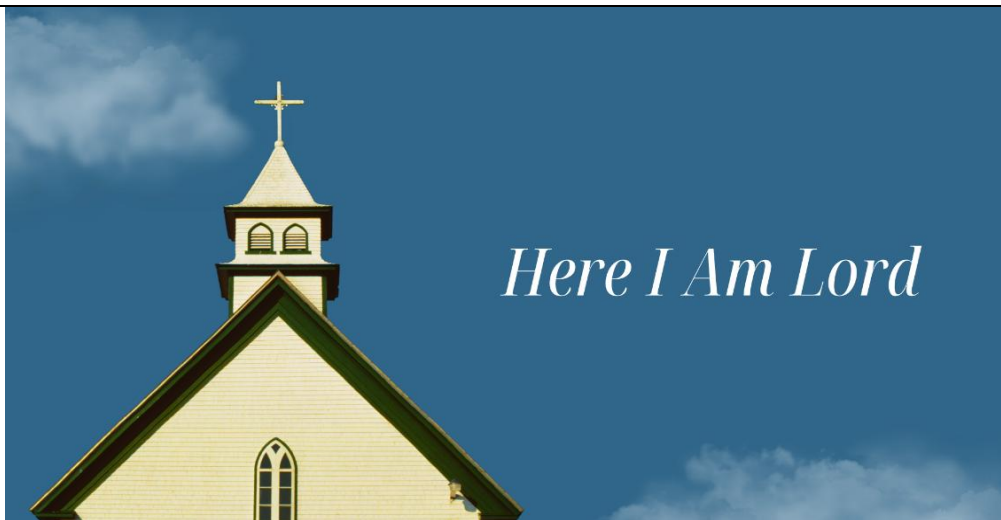
