ELEMENTARY SCHOOL UNIFORM



AT GMC, STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO FOLLOW THE ELEMENTARY UNIFORM GUIDELINES. SEE UNIFORM GUIDELINES HERE.

- ★ Red GMC or unit crest polo shirt
- ★ Khaki shorts or pants (no cargo pockets); Girls may wear Khaki skorts
- ★ Pants are required in winter months
- ★ Black tennis shoes (may have white soles and white logos)
- ★ White visible socks (no colors or designs)
- ★ GMC Fleece jacket, GMC rain jacket, or GMC Junior Bulldogs sweatshirt
- ★ Black belt with tucked in shirts required for grades 2-5
- ★ Hair-bows must be Red, Black, White or a combination of the three (Monograms are acceptable)

K-5 DROP-OFF

Please be mindful of the possibility of increased wait time in the car rider line. Students should be prepared to get out of the car quickly when they get to the front of the line.

DROP OFF

- ★ Students should not arrive at school before 7:00 AM. **School begins at 7:35 AM**
- ★ Students must be dropped off at the designated car rider drop off point to a staff member on duty. K-5 students may **NOT** walk to school without a parent or guardian
- ★ Please have your child exit on the **RIGHT** side of the vehicle. This is a safety precaution
- ★ **Students need to be unbuckled and ready to get out.** If they are not ready, you may be asked to park and walk your student to the door



K-5 PICK-UP

- ★ Students are dismissed at **3:00 P.M.**
- ★ Students must be picked up by a parent or guardian displaying the GMC Car Rider Pick Up Tag in the elementary Car Rider line **no later than 3:30 PM daily**
- ★ They are not permitted to remain on campus with a sibling, friend, etc.
- ★ Students in the After School Program will be picked up from the upstairs lobby
- ★ Parents/Guardians will need to be buzzed in

K-5TH GRADE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- ★ Daily 3:30-5:30pm
- ★ Prep School faculty and staff serve as teachers
- ★ A snack is provided (students may bring their own)
- ★ K-1st grades are in one group; play outside, watch a movie, STEM bins, special activities
- ★ 2nd-5th grades are grouped together; homework, play outside, watch a movie, play games
- ★ Fees are paid through your Blackbaud Tuition account

FULL TIME STUDENT

This is for the student who will need to stay after school on average of three or more days per week.

The cost is \$1,200 for the year. This fee will be paid with your tuition monthly.

PART TIME STUDENT

This is for the student who will need to stay after school three or less days per week. Part Time Student also includes those who may only need to stay every other week, or on an “as needed” basis – even if it’s just one day per month or semester.

The cost is \$9 per day. This fee is billed monthly based on daily attendance.

Kindergarten: Standards based-Exceeds, Meets, Progressing

HOMEWORK: Students receive homework every day/week. It is important that they spend a few minutes practicing at home. Take that time to learn what your child is doing in school!

Ensuring the safety and well-being of our students is our top priority. Our dedicated Campus Police team is committed to providing a secure and supportive environment for all our students. They are here to assist with any safety concerns, provide emergency response services, and ensure that our campus remains a safe place for our students to learn, grow, and succeed.

PREP SCHOOL DINING OPTIONS

- ★ Students use their ID card to scan their meal plan or their Bulldog Card account
- ★ K-5 students eat lunch in the Bulldog Café daily
- ★ Parents are welcome to eat lunch with their student anytime
- ★ Students may bring their lunch or choose from the café meals
- ★ Students in 3-5 are allowed to use the microwaves. Please ensure they understand how to use a microwave and understand that metal cannot go inside
- ★ 3-5 students choose what goes on their trays
- ★ K-2 students receive a pre-loaded meal tray with the meal of the day

MEAL PLANS

Families purchase a set number of meals from the Bulldog Card system **here**.

K-2 Meal Plan- \$807.50 (1 meal per day)

3-5 Meal Plan- \$935.00 (1 meal/trip through the line per day)

BULLDOG CARD ACCOUNT

Funds can be added to your student's account/ID using the Bulldog Card Online system **you can access here**.

Students can purchase a meal or a la carte items up to the amount loaded on the Bulldog Card account.

Parents should ensure their student's account has the proper funds. The system does have an alert feature, parents can choose to receive alerts when funds are low.

TUITIONS:

Financial enrollment, tuition, and fee payments are processed through Blackbaud Tuition.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

Scholarship applications open in October. Online Scholarship Applications are processed through Blackbaud Aid.
