### ACCIAL FOR 4TH & 5TH GRADE


- \*Acker Hall is home to GMC Prep's 4th and 5th grades this school year!
- ★4th and 5th grade students will be dropped off and picked up at the Jenkins Hall/Annex drop off/pick up point
- **★ No student will be picked up or dropped off at Acker Hall**
- ★Checking a 4th and 5th grade student in late or out early will be done through the main office of Jenkins Hall/Annex
- \*Students will only travel between the buildings with a teacher or staff member
- ★ Exploratory and Lunch will be in Jenkins Hall/Annex

### K-5 DROP-OFF

Please be mindful of the possibility of increased wait time in the car rider line. Students should be prepared to get out of the car quickly when they get to the front of the line.

#### DROP OFF

- ★ Students should not arrive at school before 7:00 AM. School begins at 7:35 AM
- ★ Students must be dropped off at the designated car rider drop off point to a staff member on duty. K-5 students may **NOT** walk to school without a parent or guardian
- ★ Please have your child exit on the **RIGHT** side of the vehicle.
  This is a safety precaution
- Students need to be unbuckled and ready to get out. If they are not ready, you may be asked to park and walk your student to the door



### K-5 PICK-UP

- Students are dismissed at 3:00 PM
- Students must be picked up by a parent or guardian displaying the GMC Car Rider Pick Up Tag in the elementary Car Rider line no later than 3:30 PM daily
- They are not permitted to remain on campus with a sibling, friend, etc.
- Students in the After School Program will be picked up from the upstairs lobby
- Parents/Guardians will need to be buzzed in

#### K-5TH GRADE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

#### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- ★ Daily 3:30-5:30pm
- ★ Prep School faculty and staff serve as teachers
- $\bigstar$  A snack is provided (students may bring their own)
- ★ K-1st grades are in one group; play outside, watch a movie, STEM bins, special activities
- ★ 2nd-5th grades are grouped together; homework, play outside, watch a movie, play games
- ★ Fees are paid through your Blackbaud Tuition account

#### **FULL TIME STUDENT**

- This is for the student who will need to stay after school on average of three or more days per week.
- The cost is \$1,200 for the year. This fee will be paid with your tuition monthly.

#### **PART TIME STUDENT**

- This is for the student who will need to stay after school three or less days per week. Part Time Student also includes those who may only need to stay every other week, or on an "as needed" basis even if it's just one day per month or semester.
- The cost is \$9 per day. This fee is billed monthly based on daily attendance.

**HOMEWORK:** Students receive homework every day/week. It is important that they spend a few minutes practicing at home. Take that time to learn what your child is doing in school!



**EMAIL:** Check regularly. We email a lot

**DOJO:** Your child's teacher will give you a code

**WEEKLY FOLDERS:** Important announcements, graded papers, homework

**AGENDAS:** Check daily for Discipline Codes





Families purchase a set number of meals from the Bulldog Card system **here**.

K-2 Meal Plan- \$807.50 (1 meal per day)

3-5 Meal Plan- \$935.00 (1 meal/trip through the line per day)

#### **BULLDOG CARD ACCOUNT**

Funds can be added to your student's account/ID using the Bulldog Card Online system **you can access** <u>here</u>.

Students can purchase a meal or a la carte items up to the amount loaded on the Bulldog Card account.

Parents should ensure their student's account has the proper funds. The system does have an alert feature, parents can choose to receive alerts when funds are low.
