Important words for all of us regarding our Baptism ...

Pope Leo XIV met with a group of catechumens undergoing Christian initiation, along with their sponsors and instructors. During the meeting, the Pope delivered a profound message on the meaning of Baptism:

Baptism introduces us into communion with Christ and gives us life. It commits us to reject a culture of death ... which is very present in our society. This culture of death is manifested today through indifference, contempt for others, drug use, the pursuit of an easy life, a sexuality that becomes entertainment and objectification of the human person, and injustice.



The pope also reminded them that formation does not end with Baptism, but is a lifelong journey. In this sense, he encouraged those present to remain steadfast and open to grace.

You are called to share your experience of faith with others, bearing witness to Christ's love and becoming missionary disciples. Do not limit yourselves to theoretical knowledge; live your faith in a concrete way, experiencing God's love in your daily lives. Continue growing in faith with courage and hope, becoming witnesses of the Gospel.




Palabras importantes para todos nosotros sobre nuestro Bautismo...

El Papa León XIV se reunió con un grupo de catecúmenos que se preparaban para la iniciación cristiana, junto con sus padrinos e instructores. Durante el encuentro, el Papa les transmitió un profundo mensaje sobre el significado del Bautismo:

El Bautismo nos introduce en la comunión con Cristo y nos da vida. Nos compromete a rechazar la cultura de la muerte, tan presente en nuestra sociedad. Esta cultura de la muerte se manifiesta hoy a través de la indiferencia, el desprecio por los demás, el consumo de drogas, la búsqueda de una vida fácil, una sexualidad que se convierte en entretenimiento y cosificación de la persona humana, y la injusticia.

El Papa también les recordó que la formación no termina con el Bautismo, sino que es un camino que dura toda la vida. En este sentido, animó a los presentes a permanecer firmes y abiertos a la gracia.

Están llamados a compartir su experiencia de fe con los demás, dando testimonio del amor de Cristo y convirtiéndose en discípulos misioneros. No se limiten al conocimiento teórico; vivan su fe de manera concreta, experimentando el amor de Dios en su vida diaria. Continúen creciendo en la fe con valentía y esperanza, convirtiéndose en testigos del Evangelio.


